



A LOW-CUT tolerant Kentucky bluegrass

Arcadia is the type of bluegrass that can perform exceptionally in very demanding situations. Due to its ability to withstand mowing heights of 1/2" and above, Arcadia is highly recommended for golf courses, sod production, athletic fields, as well as home lawns.

- Rich, dark-green color, even under low-cut maintenance
- Rapid germination
- Excellent disease resistance
- Medium leaf texture
- High tiller density
- Very responsive to nitrogen
- Ability to withstand low mowing
- Aggressive, vigorous, good spreading
