Clearwater has been developed to take advantage of superior genetic characteristics at a reasonable price for the professional market. **Clearwater** is a variety selected from a three way cross of “big seeded” Kentucky bluegrass types. **Clearwater** is a specialized variety developed for low cost applications in areas requiring a better turf quality than common Kentucky bluegrass varieties such as Kenblue, Newport, Park, Argyle, Huntsville, Geronimo and Alene. It was selected for medium dark color, aggressive stand establishment, better leaf texture, improved density, and aggressive growth characteristics. **Clearwater** would be most similar to varieties such as Viva, Goldrush, Marquis, Abbey, and Gnome

Agronomic Characteristics

- Moderate level of turf quality in both high and low maintenance turf regimes.
- Medium dark green color, even under low to moderate nitrogen fertility levels and restricted moisture.
- Medium leaf texture.
- High tiller density and medium tensile strength.
- Aggressive, vigorous, spreading growth habit.
- Rapid seed germination and vigorous establishment.
- Sustained turf quality and color from early spring through late fall.
- A good level of resistance to rust, powdery mildew, leaf spot and necrotic ring spot.
- Excellent in blends

Seeding Rate

New Lawn: 2-4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. feet
Established Lawn: 1-3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. feet

Clearwater is an excellent variety to blend with other bluegrasses, perennial ryegrass, fine fescues and tall fescue.
