Bred to withstand environmental stresses over a wide geographic area, Rugby can be classified as "environmentally tolerant." Of particular delight to homeowners and professionals is Rugby's ability to provide high quality turf even at both low-moderate fertility levels and limited moisture.

Agronomic Characteristics

- Medium dark green, even under low-moderate nitrogen and water inputs.
- Medium leaf texture
- High tiller density
- Ability to withstand low mowing
- Aggressive, vigorous, good spreading
- Excellent seedling vigor
- Based on 38 test sites, Rugby has good disease resistance to:
 - Leafspot and melting out (Helminthosporium)
 - Powdery Mildew (Erysiphe graminis)
 - Dollar Spot (Sclerotinia homeocarpa)
 - Stem Rust (Puccinia graminis)
 - Fusarium blight

New Lawn: 2-4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. feet
Established Lawn: 1-3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. feet
